## TOWER BOOKING

We are delighted that you would like to ring at St Mary's – the Parish Church of Burry Port, South Wales. St. Mary's, opened on 9 December 1877, is one of the finer large Victorian churches in the St Davids Diocese. It was a gift to the town by the Elkington Family of Birmingham who were silversmiths. The odd number of bells (5) represent their five sons. The tenor bell weighs 7cwt and the ring is in the key of B flat. The bells have been unringable for 30 years but with the arrival of a ringing vicar, were brought back into action in 2008. There is still work to be done – not least in training a band here - but they are in good ringing order and we enjoy hear them being rung. Please complete the form below and we will make arrangements for your visit. There is no formal charge but we suggest a donation of £2 a rope to help with the large amount of money that we have and will continue to invest in the tower. The ringing chamber is accessed via a spiral staircase of 50 steps.
